Meet Lydia Middaugh Quay The Quilter

Someone once said that all of life is about coming home. That makes a lot of sense to me because this is my first solo show and this is where my personal journey began . . . right here in Big Flats. I've learned over the past 30 years there will always be greater and lesser quilters than I am but I have also learned that I have been "called" to be a quilter. Find something you love to do and that becomes your single motivation for doing more. Even as a child I designed and made doll clothes. My early doll houses were cardboard structures I taped and glued together. When my father taught me to use a sewing machine those early designs grew into clothes for myself. I graduated from Lock Haven University with a degree in Special Education and from the College of St. Rose with a master's degree. I have taught school for the past 35 years in Lowville, NY. I have raised four wonderful children. I still teach full time. I also teach wool appliqué to enthusiastic adults in Utica, NY. Currently I have a class of young students I teach sewing to in my private studio. I see my young self in the faces of these students and it excites me to see their potential. It seems all of life has been motivation for my work. I am starting a new venture of quilt designs "Charlie's Daughter Wool Designs". My new designs are wool appliqué and formed around colorful birds I call "attitude birds". The birds are depicted with humor as they experience life situations. These new wool designs should be coming out this fall. No one comes through a life such as mine without an awful lot of support from my family and friends. Thanks so much for the opportunity to have my first show right here in Big Flats where it all began where my Father, Charlie Middaugh was the first President of the Big Flats Historical Society.

Pat brought a lot of pleasure to the Community Center and the Town Hall with fresh flowers during the summer season. Pat we will miss you and we thank you for all that you did to brighten our day.

I have received several calls about homeowners not receiving their rebate from Taxation and Finance for their school and town taxes. The Town of Big Flats did stay under the Tax Cap for the last two years and was awarded the rebate from the State of New York. If you have not received yours by May 1, 2016 you need to call 518-453-8146. Please call this number as the town does not administrate this program. There will be a second round of checks going out this fall as we stayed under the Tax Cap again this year.

I want to thank Paul Stein for his help in replacing two doors on the Little League building at the Community Park Paul thank you for donating your time.

We continue to work with the I86 corridor group on URI and CFA grants for the town. Utilities and vibrant community are the two main grants that we will be working with in 2016. Jobs is the main focus of the I86 group. In the coming months there will be several announcements about new jobs for our area. Water to the north side of I86 for the Davenport and Olcott Road areas have been targeted along with Daniel Zenker Road. The bid for the new pump station at I86 exit 52 has been awarded to Streeter and should be completed by late September. This will allow us to receive water from the Elmira system and Elmira to have a backup for the Walmart Plaza area. We continue to get enquiries as to lead in our system. We do not have any lead pipes nor pipes that are lined with lead. The system uses only Ductile Iron or Plastic piping with cooper service lines. If you have questions please call the Water Department at 562-8443 ext. 227.

I want to thank a special person for the hard work with the Big Flats Times, Tammy Stein is our editor and chief in charge of the newspaper. She has done a great job and there is not a week that goes by or a neighborhood meeting that I do not get a compliment on the newspaper. Tammy has done a great job letting citizens in Big Flats know what is happening in the town and on behalf of the Town of Big Flats, Tammy thanks for all that you do for Big Flats.

The Library Advocates

The Big Flats Library Advocates have two projects we're excited about.

The first one is the building of a Reading Garden Pavilion that will be located behind the library. We've contracted with the Amish Workshop to build it and the town will put down the cement pad. (A great big thanks to Ed Fairbrother, Tim Gilbert and Chris Austin). The pavilion will be used by the library staff to hold classes, conduct story hour and for meetings. The library patrons will be able to use their electronic devices out there, sit quietly among the beautiful flowers and read or just enjoy the outdoors. Big Flats Water Department News

Spring has finally arrived. The Water Department would like to take this time to discuss some of the important projects we have scheduled for 2016.

The new water rates went into effect this past January. They were approved by the Board in November 2015 after public meetings and a public hearing. You can find these rates on the Town’s website. Our monthly billed customers were billed the new rates starting with the February 2016 bill. Our quarterly billed customers will see these rates starting with the April bill for old Water District 1 and Water District 4 (Harris Hill Manor) accounts, May for the old Water District 2 accounts and finish up with old Water District 3 accounts in June.

The construction of the interconnection with the Elmira Water Board will begin the first week of May and should be completed by August. Streeter Associates has been awarded this project and we look forward to working with them. This emergency connection project is a major step in assuring Town residents will never be without water.

The Water Department is due for its Lead and Copper testing this year. We will be sending out letters notifying certain residents that their property has been selected as a lead and copper sample site. These sites are selected from a criteria set by the New York State EPA and the New York State Department of Health. Homes that were built from 1982–1986 will be the first selected. The Water Department asks that if you receive our letter, please respond as advised so we can continue to maintain the quality of water expected by our customers. We have scheduled these tests in June and July. Instructions will follow in the sampling kit our staff will drop off. You may contact the Water Department, 562-8443 ext. 227, if you have any questions or concerns. As summer approaches please try and be conservative with one of nature’s greatest resources.
