


What & When: The Town of Big Flats Parks Department is installing a new playground at Community Park Extension off of Route 352 and Winters Rd. We are looking for volunteers to help assemble the new playground between 8am and 5pm on Friday, August 21 and Saturday, August 22. Volunteers will help unpack materials, build play structures and set in the ground. The playground was purchased from [GameTime](#), who will have project managers on site to assist with construction as well as employees from the Public Works Department and Town Board Members.

Where: Community Park Extension, 1 Registro Dr. (Registro Way), by the pavilion



What to do: Email Laura Sullivan at the Department of Public Works dpw@bigflatsny.gov if you are attending and when you will be there. We are ideally looking for 18-20 volunteers each of the two days. We prefer volunteers sign up for both days if possible to minimize training new volunteers. At minimum, we hope you can volunteer for 4-5 hour blocks. If you want to help, but are not certain of your availability or would like more information, you may call Laura at 562-8443 x224.

What to Bring:

- Work Gloves
- Sturdy Shoes (sneakers, boots, closed toe, no high heels). Expect to be on your feet and active.
- Clothing you are comfortable to work in
- Sunscreen
- Hat or ball cap
- Eye protection (safety glasses)
- A highlighted tool list of items that would be helpful for you to bring is attached. If you bring something please make sure it's labeled with your name and phone number.

What's Provided: Town of Big Flats will be providing drinks and snacks throughout the day. Lunch will be provided as well. Restrooms will be open.

Tool List for your GameTime[®] Playground Installation

Warning: Installation of playground equipment over a hard surface such as concrete, asphalt, or packed earth may result in serious injury from falls.

General Tools:

- Transit or Builder's Level & Rod
- Stakes, String, Marking Paint
- Post Hole Digger or Auger
- Wheel Barrow
- Utility Knives
- Tape Measures
- Rock Bar
- Round Point Shovels
- Hoes
- Rakes
- 6' Step Ladder
(not required for a TotTime or KidCourse unit)
- 8' or 12' Step Ladder
(if unit has roofs)
- Bricks or Blocks for the bottom of the ground holes
- Adjustable Wrench
- Channel Lock Pliers
- Vise Grip Pliers
- Line-Up Tool or "Drift Pin"
- Ratchets and Socket Set
- Rat Tail File
- 3/8" Drive to 1/4" Quick Change Socket
- Rubber Hammer
- Tie-Down Straps or 6" Quick Grips
- 4' Level
- Cordless Drill and Assorted Size Drill Bits up to 17/32" or Electric Drill with Extension Cords
- Power Source (Generator or Outlet)
- Concrete Truck or Mixer (at end of job)
- Sledge Hammer (for driving stakes if installing play curbs)
- Bolt Cutters (for chain adjustment if installing swings)
- S-Hook Pliers (if installing swings, chain net climbers, trapeze bars or rings)

Important Note: Please call your utility companies before you start digging in order to help prevent any damage to power, water, or gas lines.
