SNAP Low Cost Spay/Neuter clinics are intended for area residents who can not afford the spay/neuter fees charged at their veterinarian's office due to financial hardship.

- High quality, low cost spay/neuter is available to area residents for their cats and dogs.
- Veterinary services are provided by Shelter Outreach Services of Ithaca.
- Clinics are generally held the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of every month; however these are subject to change. More dates may be added.
- The clinics are held at: Chemung County Humane Society and SPCA

- Each clinic will accommodate about 20 cats and 8 dogs.
- **ALL SERVICES MUST BE PAID IN EITHER CASH OR CREDIT CARD AT TIME OF CHECK-IN. NO CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Your pet **MUST** be up-to-date on Rabies and Distemper Vaccinations in order to use this service.
- If your pet **IS up to date** on its vaccinations, **you must bring proof with you on the morning of surgery.** If your pet **IS NOT up to date** or you fail to provide proof you will be charged \$15.00 **at check-in** for each shot needed. No exceptions.
- Nursing females will not be eligible until babies have been weaned.
- I understand that if in the course of treatment a condition is discovered that requires medical attention or an additional procedure, such as hernia repair or the administration of IV fluids, the attending veterinarian may, in his/her absolute discretion, perform such procedure. I understand and will be prepared to pay reasonable charges, if any, at time of check out.
- Unless previous arrangements are made with SPCA management, pick up of the animal will be same day. Failure to pick up animal on the day of surgery will result in boarding charges of \$25.00 per animal per day to be paid before retrieval of animal(s).
- Drop off and pick up times for clinics are as follows:

7:30	Dog drop off	Between 5:00 - 6:00pm	Dog pick up
8:00	Cat drop off	Between 6:00 - 6:30pm	Cat pick up

****If you are bringing both dogs and cats drop off time will be 7:30am and pick up time will be between 6:00 - 6:30pm**

Thank you for applying to have your dog or cat spayed or neutered through the Chemung County SPCA SNAP program. We have partnered with SOS (Shelter Outreach Services) and many donors and dedicated volunteers to provide low-cost, high-quality spay and neuter services to area pet owners facing financial hardship. By surgically removing reproductive organs, we can humanely reduce the number of unwanted animals and pet overpopulation in our area.

Please fill out the application completely. Incomplete applications will delay an earlier spot in the clinic.

Applications are reviewed as soon as received. If there is a problem and we are unable to reach you, the application goes on hold until resolved. You will be contacted as soon as we can schedule. At this time there is a large waiting list of applicants extended out several months and we encourage clients to save for the fee.

Your pet must be current on rabies and distemper shots in order to use this service. If your pet is up to date, you must bring proof on the morning of the clinic. If your pet needs vaccinations, the cost is \$15.00 per vaccination. If your female animal is pregnant or in heat there is an additional fee of \$10.00. If your male animal is cryptorchid or double cryptorchid (retained testicles) there is an additional fee of \$10.00-\$20.00 that will be due at the time of pick up. If your pet has ear mites s/he will be treated and \$5.00 will be charged, payable at time of pick up.

ALL PAYMENTS ARE TO BE MADE IN CASH or CREDIT CARDS. We do not accept checks.

After we receive a completed application you will be contacted by phone to confirm receipt of your application. You will then be contacted by phone to set up an appointment in an upcoming clinic when a spot becomes available. You will receive a reminder letter from the scheduler about 1-2 weeks before your appointment, which will include your appointment date and further instructions.

If you have to cancel an appointment, please call the scheduler at the phone number provided on the confirmation letter as soon as possible so that a new appointment can be scheduled, and your original slot given to another client. Failure to keep the appointment without first contacting the scheduler will cause your application to be placed in the inactive file and moved to the end of the list. You will be required to prepay if you want to reschedule.
